assistance. Zion is not considered a medical
based facility, certain insurance companies do
not cover services. Fees are determined by
current gross income, using a sliding fee scale
based on current poverty guidelines.

Residential is a peer based dictated
program that adopts the formulas from the
12 steps, but utilizes other treatment
alternatives to meet the client where they
at in their recovery.

Residential is 28 to 45 days stay
