- Can bring pillow and blanket but we do supply these items
- Religious resources
- Cigarettes in sealed package / Nicotine gum, lozenges or patches
- Personal photos of family, no indecent photos
- Money for vending machines (ones only)
- \$200 for admission fee

Items required before being admitted to the facility

- 45 day supply of all medication
- Current TB test and physical

These are required prior to admission you will be turned away if you do not have these items present at time of admission, certain arrangements can be made prior to admission date by contacting (712) 542-3720. Can be faxed prior to admission date (712) 542-3723

Items that should Not be brought with you

- Cells phones
- Knives or other weapons
- Zippo lighters
- Personal Vehicles (arrange a ride to treatment and from treatment)
- Personal electronics
- No plain orange or gray shirts
- No smokeless tobacco, e-cigs or snuff is allowed at treatment
